Stepping down

Sometimes, you get the impression that someone has always been there. You can't quite imagine that particular corner of the world without them. Well, in this case, that someone is Martin Buckley and the corner is the OSPS committee. And he has been there a long time.

In 1977 Martin was running the Survey Office at Billericay but attending an ONC course in Southampton. In 1978 he transferred to Southampton but was on an HNC course at Walthamstow. Life was busy back then but he still found time join OSPS, though whether it was 1977 or 1978 is uncertain. Even so, it wasn't long before the committee was beckoning and during the 1981-82 season he took on the responsibilities of secretary. As if that wasn't enough, Martin took the position of Chairman in 1982-83. Enticing though committee work is, the outside world was calling and during 1983~1985 Martin was on secondment in the Seychelles. A terrible job but someone had to do it! From 1985 to1986 it was back to (slightly) less sunny Glasgow and an MSc course at the university.

Finally tiring of endless sun, beaches and academia, Martin returned to committee duties for 1987-88 as Vice Chairman and was back as Chairman the following season. Between 1991~1999 it was Vice Chairman again, 1993~1998 Membership Secretary, 2000 Chairman and Programme Secretary, 2001~2014 Secretary, Website Editor and Programme Secretary (not so much a glutton for punishment, more not having enough committee members!). And finally for 2014~2015, Competition Secretary and Website Editor, whereupon Martin has decided it's time to step down.

Like any club, OSPS needs a committee to function efficiently. But, like many clubs, it's never easy to find people willing to serve on the committee, let alone someone willing to serve over an extended period. So thank you Martin, for so many years service.
